Course Title: CU Succeeds Language Arts: ENGL 1020 Core Composition

Department: Language Arts

Grade Level(s): 12 (11 with counselor approval)

Fees and Materials: To be determined by CU

Course Description

This course provides opportunities to write for different purposes and audiences, with an emphasis on learning how to respond to various rhetorical situations; improving critical thinking, reading and writing abilities; understanding various writing processes; and gaining a deeper knowledge of language conventions.

Course Title: CU Succeeds Language Arts: ENGL 1200 Introduction to Fiction

Department: Language Arts

Grade Level (s): 12 (11 with counselor approval)

Fees and Materials: To be determined by CU

Course Description

This course introduces class members to the works of famous authors as well as to major themes, elements and techniques of fiction in both short stories and novels.

Course Title: CU Succeeds Elective: FA 1150 Introduction to Photography

Grade Level (s): 12 (11 with counselor approval)

Fees and Materials: To be determined by CU

Course Description: Introduces the breadth of photographic practice. Techniques covered in the course include an in-depth exploration of how to use your camera, film processing, basic black and white printing, color photography alternative processes, digital imaging and other photographic techniques. This course builds a foundation for critical thinking and intelligent image making through readings, presentation, idea development and expressive uses of the medium.

Course Title: CU Succeeds Social Studies:P SC 1001-3 Introduction to Political Science

Department: Social Studies

Grade Level(s): 12 (11 with counselor approval)

Prerequisite: US History

Course Description

This course introduces the study of politics, its human importance and its relationship to social institutions. Analysis of the relationship between individual political behavior and characteristics of the political system.

Course Title: CU Succeeds Social Studies:P SC 1101-3 American Political System

Department: Social Studies

Grade Level(s): 12 (11 with counselor approval)

Fees and Materials: To be determined by CU

Prerequisite: US History

Course Description

This course introduces the American political system with emphasis upon citizen involvement, the relationships among the various levels and branches of government, formal and informal institutions, processes and behaviors.

Course Title: CU Succeeds Science: PHYS 1000-4 Introduction to Physics: GT-SCI

Department: Science

Grade Level(s): 12 (11 with counselor approval)

Fees and Materials: To be determined by CU

Prerequisites: Earth Science, Biology, Chemistry, and IMP3

Course Description

This course is an introductory survey course for nonscientists that emphasize the main concepts of physics. Although this course is mainly descriptive, some high school algebra will be used. The accompanying laboratory work is designed to illustrate the material discussed in the lectures.

Course Title: CU Succeeds Science: ENVS 1000– 4 Introduction to Environmental Studies

Department: Science

Grade Level(s): 12 (11 with counselor approval)

Fees and Materials: To be determined by CU

Course Description: This course surveys environmental studies, examining ecological, socioeconomic, political, aesthetic, and technological factors that influence the quality of life on Earth. Required for ENVS majors. Approved for arts and sciences core curriculum: natural science.
