

Lettering in Stagecraft & Design

Lettering is an honor comparable to schools with sports teams and academics with high standards. High school students may letter once a year—with each year they receive a Chenille letter (which can be applied to a letter jacket) and then pins/bars for accomplishments.

To letter in Stagecraft & Design students must earn 1000 points, determined by the following point scale:

Class Work

Receiving an "A" in S & D for a 9 week report card	50
3.5 Honor roll for 9 weeks	50
4.0 Honor roll for 9 weeks	75

Design Work

Design a main-stage DSA production	200
Design a non main-stage DSA production	100
Design a non DSA play, concert or event	up to 200

Production Work

Stage manage a main-stage DSA production	200
Master electrician, wardrobe supervisor, sound supervisor, set crew chief in a main-stage DSA production	100
Crew member for a main-stage production	50
Master electrician, wardrobe supervisor, sound supervisor, set crew chief for a non main-stage DSA production	50
Crew member for a non main-stage DSA production	25
Stage manage a non DSA play, concert or event	up to 200
Master electrician, wardrobe supervisor, sound supervisor, set crew chief a non DSA play, concert or event	up to 100
Crew member for a non DSA play, concert or event	50

Other work

Service project for S & D Department	up to 100
Service project for DSA	up to 100
Tutoring a Stagecraft Major from a lower level	up to 50
Design, drawing or other applicable classes taken out side of school	up to 50
Thespian Officer	50
Thespian Membership	50
Documented Attendance at any DSA production (provide ticket)	10
Documented Attendance at any non-DSA production (provide ticket/program)	10

- Applications to letter may be submitted by April 15th of each year. Only high school students may letter, but middle school students may earn points.
- A maximum of 500 points may be carried from the middle school level. If you think you deserve credit for something that is not listed on the above point scale discuss it with the Stagecraft & Design Director.
- Points listed in each category are the MAXIMUM that can be awarded; actual points are at the discretion of the Stagecraft & Design director.
- To apply, you must fill out all accomplishments, their point category, their director/date, and points they are applying for by APRIL 15. Points must be earned while AT DSA.
- Students can count something only once—not in two different categories.
