The newly updated annual ERCM Online Training course will be available beginning Tuesday, October 20, 2009.

What schools are required to take the annual ERCM Online Training?

All DPS schools, (Traditional, Other, Alternative, Charter, Shared Campus)

What does the ERCM Online Training include?

4 training videos, 5 quizzes, a survey and a certificate

Who at each school is required to take the ERCM Online Training?

All School Emergency Team members, including Alternates

(Any DPS school employee is welcome to take the ERCM Online Training. Employees with charter school email addresses must contact Risk Management to be set up with login usernames if not already provided by their principal/head of school.)

Where do we find the instructional steps on how to take the Online Training?

1. Open your Internet browser. Go to the DPS website Home Page and click on Emergency Response Crisis Management on the right hand navigation bar. **OR**, go directly to the ERCM website at <http://ercm.dpsk12.org>. Click on **Training**. Instructions are here for accessing the training.
2. **DPS users:** Use your DPS username and password.
Charter school users: Use the password and username provided to your principal/director/head of school.

The deadline for schools to complete the Online Training is Monday, November 23, 2009.

The ERCM Online Training is required by the District to be in compliance with State and Federal regulations.
