Principal Selection Process for Interim Principals

The following information outlines the Principal Selection Process that the Instructional Superintendent will follow with a school where an Interim Principal is currently assigned:

- The Instructional Superintendent and the Chief Academic Officer together will determine where the following process is appropriate for a school where there is currently an interim principal assigned.
- The Instructional Superintendent will meet with the school's CSC to inform them that they have the opportunity to do the following:
 - Request that the Superintendent and the Chief Academic Officer waive the formal district Principal Selection Process and recommend to the Board of Education that their current interim principal be appointed as the principal for the following year.
 - Determine that their decision is to follow the formal district Principal Selection Process. The current interim principal may apply.
- The Instructional Superintendent will explain to the CSC that they have the right to gather input from their stakeholders in a manner that they choose before they make the determination whether they will request to either waive the process or follow the formal Principal Selection Process.
- The Superintendent and the Chief Academic Officer will review the recommendation of the CSC and the Instructional Superintendent, determine if they approve the request to retain the Interim Principal, and determine if they will move forward to seek final Board of Education approval.

Note: The Instructional Superintendent will inform the Interim Principal of this process and will keep the Interim Principal updated on the determination of the school's CSC.
