It is my understanding that there are risks of minor, serious or permanent injury or death in any recreational or sport activity and we voluntarily assume such risks. I hereby acknowledge, understand and assume the risks and potential dangers arising from the conditions and use of the facilities, equipment and premises, and participation in the Camp activities. I acknowledge and understand that included within the scope of this waiver and release is any cause of action arising from the performance or failure to perform construction, maintenance, inspection, supervision or control of the facilities, equipment and premises and/or from the failure to warn of dangerous conditions existing at said facilities, equipment or premises.

In the event there is an emergency and I cannot be reached, I hereby consent to whatever medical treatment may be considered necessary by the attending physician for me or my child (ren).
