## Grocery Cards FAQ

Sign up for the Summer Safeway gift card program. All we need is your monthly order amount and address. Then write out post-dated checks for June, July and August - write in the memo line that they're for the safeway gift card program - and put them in the locked PTSA mailbox. We will deliver the cards to your house the first week of each month.

Below are some facts regarding the new Re-loadable King Soopers cards.

- Reload the card at the store for up to \$500. It can be indefinitely.
- Reload the card at King Soopers by telling the cashier that you would like to add money to your gift card. King Soopers recommends doing this just before you ring up your groceries, then paying for your groceries with your card. 5% of what you re-load will get sent back to Park Hill PTSA in the form of a refund check.
- If you reload at a customer service desk or a register other than where they scan your groceries, your funds will be delayed for 5 minutes. So, plan on reloading where you ring up your groceries.
- Use your card to pay for both groceries and gas.
- Find out the balance on your gift card by asking your cashier to check the balance, looking at the bottom of your cash register receipt, visiting [www.gcbalance.com](http://www.gcbalance.com) or calling 866-822-6252.
- If the card sits with a zero balance for 90 days, it will become inactive. You will need to purchase a new card at school.
- Although rare, sometimes cards become demagnetized and cannot be reloaded. If this should happen to you, use the balance on your card and purchase a new card at school.
