Grocery Cards

Put in your monthly order now to begin receiving grocery cards from Safeway and/or King Soopers. Purchase the cards and 5% of the amount goes to PTSA. Spend the cards at the store just like cash. Use them to purchase anything from groceries, gas, prescriptions, and gift cards. Place a monthly order and help our school raise much-needed funds. Below are some facts regarding re-loadable King Soopers cards.

- When the balance is low, reload the card at the store for up to \$500.
- To reload the card, tell the cashier that you would like to add money to your gift card. King Soopers recommends doing this just before you ring up your groceries, then paying for your groceries with your card. 5% of what you re-load is sent back to Park Hill PTSA in the form of a refund check.
- Plan on reloading where you ring up your groceries. If you reload at a customer service desk or a register other than where you scan groceries, funds are delayed five minutes.
- Find out the balance on your gift card by asking your cashier to check the balance, looking at the bottom of your cash register receipt, visiting www.gcbalance.com, or calling 866-822-6252.
- If the card sits with a zero balance for 90 days, it will become inactive. You will need to purchase a new card at school.
- Although rare, sometimes cards become demagnetized and cannot be reloaded. If this should happen to you, use the balance on your card and purchase a new card at school.
