Fact Sheet & Parent/Guardian Permission Slip

About the Sale: 50% of the proceeds from every bar sold goes to Park Hill!

Starting next Friday, November 13, students will have the opportunity to sell World's Finest Chocolate dollar bars. 50¢ of every \$1 chocolate bar students sell goes to the Park Hill PTSA to help pay for paraprofessionals who assist our teachers in the classroom, reading interventionists working with early readers, and crossing guards, just to name a few.

2009 Chocolate Sale Details

- **Win prizes!** Sell one box of chocolate or more and win! Turn the page over for more info.
- **Permission slips due Monday, November 9** back to classrooms. *We must have a signature, phone number & email on the permission slip in order to give a box of chocolate to your child.*
- **Chocolate sale begins Friday, November 13!** Chocolate will be distributed to participating students in class that afternoon. When your student sells all of the chocolate, return the money in class from the first box and we will give your student more boxes to sell. *If possible, we ask that students give the cash to you and ask that you write a check made out to Park Hill PTSA.*
 - **Morning money collection:** Chocolate Sale Volunteers will visit every classroom every day of the sale to collect money and find out if students want to sell more chocolate – it will be brought to the classroom that afternoon.
 - **Chocolate Store open 3:00 – 3:30 p.m.:** Additional chocolate may be collected from the chocolate storage room (*on the split level above the auditorium*) immediately after school, Monday, November 16 – Monday, November 30.
- **Returning unsold chocolate:** If your student is having a problem selling all of his/her chocolate, please return it in perfect sellable condition **by the morning of November 24th**. We will then repackage it for other students to sell. *Please do not return chocolate after this date because we will not have enough time to resell.*
- **Chocolate sale ends Tuesday, December 1.** Chocolate Sale Volunteers will visit classrooms in the morning to finish collecting money from the sale.
