THE SPACE THEATRE (WHITEHALL THEATRE) IS LOCATED TO THE RIGHT OF THE LOBBY OF THE BONFILS COMPLEX DOWNSTAIRS. THERE IS AN ELEVATOR IF NEEDED IT IS CALLED THE WHITEHALL, AND IS IN THE ROUND. THERE ARE RESTROOMS IN THE SPACE THEATRE, THE JONES THEATRE, THE BONFILS LOBBY, AND THE BOETTCHER HALL LOBBY.**
