There will be no elimination in case of missed answers, but winners will be the team scoring the most points. At the end of the Challenge Bowl, awards will be given to the winning teams. You may enter three students for your team. Only three students may participate. You may have 2 alternates in case of absence on the day of the festival. We will use the new configuration for The Challenge Bowl.

Please make sure all information is complete for all students. Student participants may be contacted if necessary.

Each school must submit ten questions from the two categories above. Please submit your ten questions to
