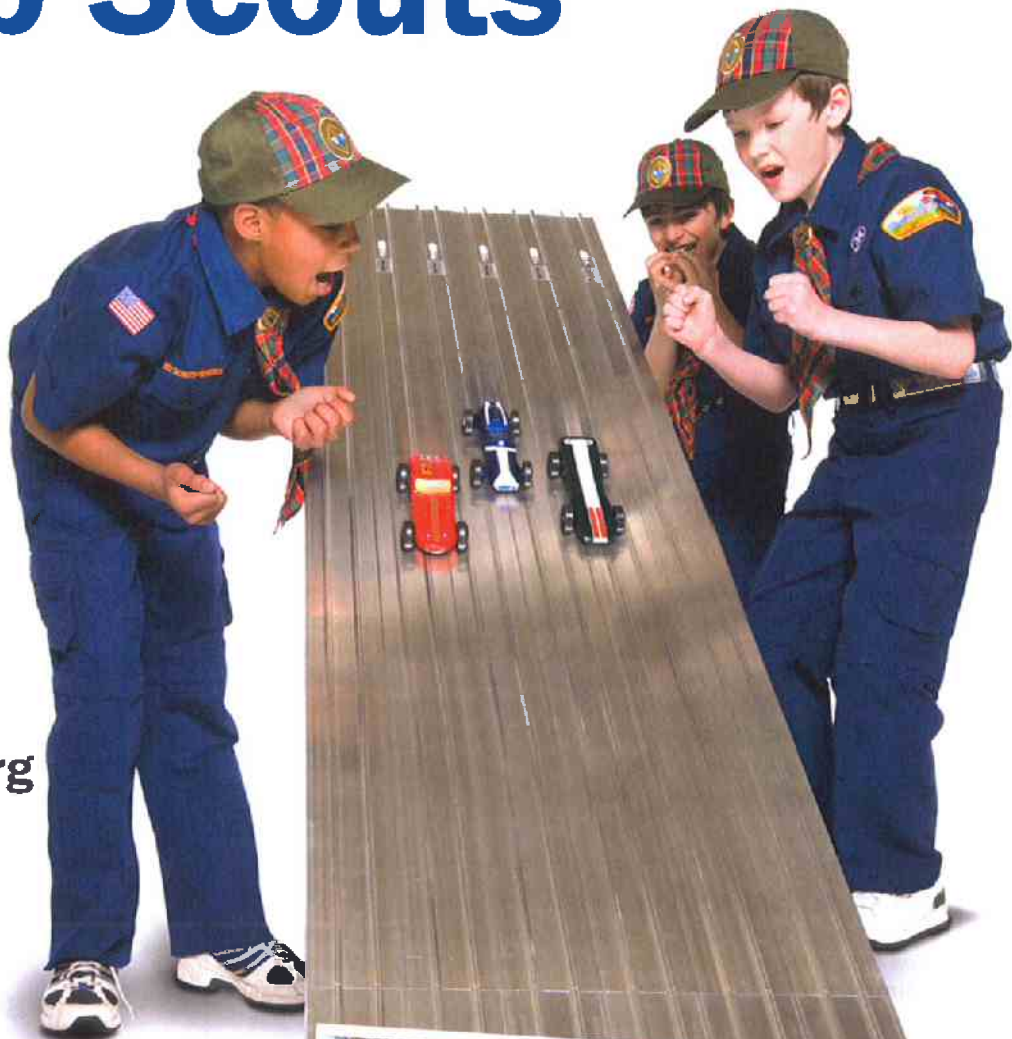

### Tiger Cubs (1st Grade)

Oriented to boys and parents, work on big ideas to search, discover, and share. Objectives: prepare family for Cub Scouting. Boys and parents work one on one with other families.



### Cub Scouts (2nd & 3rd Grades)

Family centered program. Boys meet regularly in small groups to work on projects. Learning is achieved through an advancement program. Uniforms, badges, games, sports, fun!



### Webelos Scouting (4th & 5th Grades)

Begin outdoor experiences. Boys meet regularly with adult leaders. Learning is achieved through a hobby and life skills program called activity badges.



### Frequently Asked Questions

**Question: Is there a cost?**

Answer: Registration with the Boy Scouts of America is \$10 a year. Each pack may have other small fees to cover the program costs. You can also have Boy's Life magazine mailed directly to your son at home every month for only \$12.00 a year. Remember to bring your checkbook to the meeting. However, no boy will be refused membership because of financial concerns and every Scout is afforded the opportunity to earn his own way by participating in the council wide popcorn sale.
