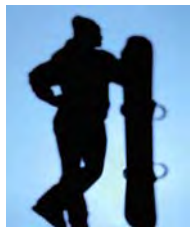

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Why should I send my child with Colorado Ski Academy?

Our program provides the opportunity for students to travel to the mountains on a fun and educational day trip with other students at a price that **SAVES YOU MONEY!!** Because we are Colorado's largest provider of student ski & snowboard trips, we are well organized and dependable. We have on-site coordination at every mountain on every trip. We get our tickets ahead of time so there is "no waiting" for students.

When will I know the Departure & Return Times and Locations?

We will post the departure and return times and locations on our website 4-5 days prior to each trip. **We also EMAIL you this information.** Your pickup location may not ALWAYS be the same location each trip, so be sure to check each time.

As a rule, departures are between 6:00AM and 7:30AM, and return times are between 4:30PM and 5:30PM. On trip days, we recommend you check the schedule page on our website after 4:30PM as we will post any return delays we are aware of. You may also call our office at 303-798-0388 for a recorded message concerning any late buses or delays.

What is the CSA Ride Pass?

We are now offering an unlimited transportation pass for just \$199 for the season! This allows you to ride up on ANY or all departures that we have, either Ski & Ride or school trips. We have approximately 27 dates scheduled this season. In conjunction with this, you may add on lift tickets or lessons at a special discounted price! Check our website for details!

Note: Only skiers or riders in Grades 6 and above who have reached level 4 or higher may enroll in a half day or no-lesson program. Students in Grades 1-5 must enroll in the full-day lesson program unless they are Level 4 or above AND skiing or boarding WITH their parent

How are students grouped into the Ski or Snowboard Classes?



All students in grades 1-5 will be in full-day lessons with instructors provided by the resort. Students in full or half-day lessons are grouped in classes by age and ability level. Parents should answer the ability questions on the registration form as best they can. Resort instructors will assess each student as the day progresses. Students in lessons should bring back a "progress card" at the end of the

day. Classes are normally no larger than 10 students per instructor.

What about transportation?

Colorado Ski Academy contracts with select companies for transportation. We use modern, deluxe motorcoaches that are restroom and video equipped. All of our contracted companies have an excellent safety record, as well as experienced mountain drivers. There are adult chaperones on board each bus.

How are younger skiers and riders chaperoned?

Many parents are hesitant at first to send their younger children alone over concerns that their child will become "lost". Parents may rest assured that all elementary aged children are supervised from the moment they board the bus until the time it returns. Colorado Ski Academy takes approximately 10,000 students each year to the mountains. We have never "left" a full-day lesson student behind!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Are Half-Day or No Lesson Skiers and Riders Chaperoned also?

Half-day and No Lesson students are chaperoned on the bus. However, once we arrive at the ski resort, it will depend on the program that they have chosen.

For those choosing a half day lesson program, students will be with an instructor until after lunch time. At this time, participants are released to ski or ride with their friends and are responsible on their own to return to the bus at the designated time and place.

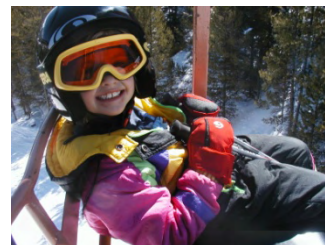
Parents who give permission for students to ski or snowboard without an instructor also agree to pick their child up from the ski resort if they do not return to the bus at the scheduled departure time. Parents should take into consideration their individual child's experience and maturity level when making this decision. All skiers and riders who are in Levels 1-3 MUST be placed in a full-day lesson program, to ensure their safety and to help them master the appropriate skills.

What about rental equipment?

CSA has arranged for special rental rates for skis and snowboards at all three resorts. Those ordering rental equipment must provide height, weight and shoe size. The resort then pre-sets the equipment before our arrival, and marks it by name. This helps the rental process go very quickly when we arrive.

It is very important that the correct sizes are put on the form or students will have to be refit.

Parents, if you are not sure about sizes, please measure your students!!!



What about helmets?

Helmets ARE provided as part of the basic equipment rental package for all students that sign up for rental equipment and are taking a lesson. Students not renting equipment through CSA, as well as students not in a lesson, who wish to wear a helmet, should either bring one, or they may sign up for a "helmet only" rental.

Is Lunch Included?

Lunch is included for all students participating in a lesson program.

At Eldora, lunch is provided for ALL students that purchase a lift ticket OR lesson package. Skiers and riders at Winter Park, Loveland or Keystone who are not in a lesson should bring lunch, or plan to purchase lunch.

Please notify us of any food allergies your child may have.

What should students bring?

Students should bring along the following items on each trip:

- Appropriate winter clothing including winter jacket (we suggest layered clothing)
- Waterproof pants (preferably insulated ski or snow pants)
- Winter Hat
- Goggles or Sunglasses (A REQUIREMENT AT EACH RESORT TO PREVENT SUNBURNED EYES!)
- Waterproof insulated gloves or mittens
- Snacks and/or a beverage for consumption on the motorcoach (Please no candy, popcorn or other small food items that spill)
- Sunscreen

Students may bring along a backpack which can be left on the bus during the day. All items should be marked with the student's name.

DO NOT SEND ITEMS THAT YOU CANNOT AFFORD TO LOSE.

CSA Ski and Ride Club is not responsible for items that are lost.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What if I need to cancel after I've signed up?

We understand that unforeseen circumstances may necessitate cancellations or no-show on a trip. We feel our cancellation policy is extremely generous. Once we have processed your registration, cancellations or no-shows, regardless of the reason, are non-refundable. However, the full amount paid (with the exception of any late fees or convenience fees) can be transferred to any future trip in the next 12 months, to be taken by the same person or another family member at the same address.

We do not make exceptions to this policy.

No refunds/credits or partial refunds/credits or discounted trips will be issued due to delays caused by road conditions, weather, traffic, mechanical, illness, sadness or sickness during the day or weather related issues at the resort.

Using Credit from a Previously Canceled Trip:

If you have credit from a previous trip, please re-register for the trip you would like to use the credit on. In the payment section, include the amount of the previous credit and include payment for any additional amount due. If you do not know the amount of your credit, please contact our office.

Is There a Discount on the Lesson Package With a Season Pass or a 5th or 6th Grade Passport?

Because our rates are already heavily discounted, there is no additional discount for students taking a lesson who have a 5th or 6th Grade Passport, or a season pass. *Our lesson packages already include a "FREE" Lift Ticket*

What about Accident/Medical Expense Protection?

All participants are covered with accident insurance while traveling on the motorcoach. Optional injury protection, which covers incidents while off the motorcoach during the day, is available for \$4.00 per person. Limitations apply, with a maximum payout of \$500.00.

Do Parents or Guardians have to attend?

No. All skier and riders are checked on the bus in the morning by adult chaperones. Chaperones supervise on the bus to and from the resort. Upon arrival at the ski area, all skiers and riders in a lesson program are met by resort instructors. They are pre-grouped by age and ability, from beginner to advance. The instructors stay with the full-day lesson participants all day (including lunch). At the end of the day, they are returned to the bus for the return trip. Half-day lesson participants are released after lunch. Half-day and No-Lesson participants are responsible to return to the bus at the designated time.

Parents are responsible for picking up their children at the designated return time; keeping in mind buses could be early or late depending upon traffic and road conditions. Buses are unable to wait for late parents.
