If your son or daughter would like to be an artist of the week, but are not sure what to bring in for display, here are some guidelines to help you work with your child to select the artwork: A finished work (not just a sketch) of art that can hang on the wall, and is ok to staple through; an original creation (not a tracing or copy of someone else's art); art that was created in an art class at school or elsewhere, or at home (not a doodle done during class time); any size of paper is fine (but please no lined notebook paper).

A great idea is to dig out all the old art work that your child has created over the years that you have been saving and send in 6 or so pieces with the student's name on the back!

Their work will be put in the line-up for future display. These would be great pieces to showcase on our artist of the week bulletin board!

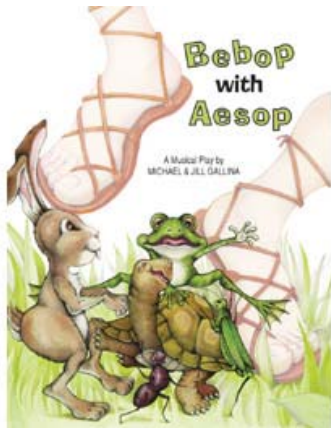
