INTRODUCTION TO SPANISH - Location: Room 206

Space Adventure Programs are activity-based, space science-themed after school programs designed to get kids energized and excited about science through unique hands-on & minds-on space science exploration activities. Though their main emphasis is on fun and interactivity, each program is structured around core principals of science and involves critical thinking exercises that encourage kids to challenge their understanding of the world they live in and the space that it inhabits. **Destination: Mars** takes kids on a virtual journey to our planetary neighbor to search for signs of Martian life and find out what living on an alien world would be like. Over the course of six weeks kids will go from launch to landing experiencing the 65 million mile spaceflight and then they will put on their mission scientist hats to remotely navigate robot rovers looking for signs of liquid water, try to scale Olympus Mons - the tallest mountain in the Solar System, search for evidence of alien life under the sands of Mars and much more. Instructor Ed Ludka is a 24 year amateur astronomer and model rocketry fanatic who has developed children's space science learning applications for a variety of space exploration advocacy groups and currently serves as the Volunteer Director for The Planetary Society for the state of Colorado.
